check-in table. You will then be directed to your assigned station and assist with prep for wine service, including an overview and basic training. Please arrive dressed for service. Please do not bring anything that you will not

need for your work at this event.

Uniform: Sommeliers: Please wear a dark suit (if you have one) or dark pants,

pressed white shirt, long black tie, dark socks and dark shoes. We prefer black suits or slacks, but dark navy would be permissible. Black ties can be

provided, upon request.

Tools: Everyone is responsible for bringing and maintaining their own corkscrew.

JBF is not responsible for belongings or tools left behind or for storing

personal items.
