

## James Beard Foundation's 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Taste America® Tour Kicks Off at the James Beard House

## Honorary Taste America All-Star Thomas Keller joined JBF President Susan Ungaro and All-Star Chefs Daniel Boulud, Traci Des Jardins, Rocco DiSpirito, Tony Mantuano, and Marc Murphy to Celebrate Culinary Collaboration across the Country

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New York, NY (August 3, 2017) – Top culinary talent from across the country joined James Beard Foundation president Susan Ungaro to kick off the <u>James Beard Foundation</u>'s 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Taste America® ten-city tour at the James Beard House last night. Honorary Taste America All-Star Thomas Keller, 2017 Taste America All-Stars Daniel Boulud, Traci Des Jardins, Rocco DiSpirito, Tony Mantuano, and Marc Murphy were among the star-studded chef line up at the invitation-only event where details of this year's culinary program were announced.

"Having chef Keller lead us into the 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary year of this national program is made even more special since he was part of an early pilot program in 2007," said Ungaro. "Not only is Thomas Keller the first American—born chef to hold multiple three-star Michelin Star ratings, but he is also the first American male chef to receive the Chevalier of the French Legion of Honor. His influence in supporting excellence in our culinary world is unparalleled."

As guests posed for selfies with the life-size cutout of James Beard, the All-Star Chefs, Keller and Ungaro mingled among an audience including JBF Board Chair Fred Seegal, Adele Schober of Breville, Blue Circle Food's Bill Cole, Reed Miller from Tabasco, and Per Se's Chef de Cuisine Eli Kaimeh, who created the menu with Chef Keller for the kick-off.

"The James Beard Foundation has contributed to the evolution of America's dining culture," said Keller. "I am delighted to serve as Honorary Chair of this year's Taste America program and lend my support to the Foundation's important mission to celebrate, nurture, and honor chefs and other leaders in our profession."
